

## Get to know each other

- Great exercises for learning names.
- Suitable both for large groups and one-on-one tuition.

### ***My name is...***

- Say your name, and then something you like beginning with the same letter as your name. ie "My name is Jenny and I like Jam!"

### **Group**

- Set the children up in a circle.
- Introduce yourself, then go around the circle. Each person has to introduce the people preceding them, before introducing themselves.
  - Ie a child four places along might say: "This is Tom, he likes tigers, this is Amanda, she likes apples, this is Charlie, he likes chips, and I am Belinda and I like Bananas!"
- Add random element, by getting children to introduce people not next to them.

### **Single**

- Sit facing each other.
- Introduce yourself, and then get the child to do the same. Repeat the exercise, each time thinking of new nouns to attribute to yourself. Ie Mary might like mandarins, mangos, music, movies etc
